Dear Parents,

Our geography topic this half term is called "Hike". This involves comparing our area of the UK with one in Utah. The children will be learning about using maps, including Google Earth and what the geography in different areas looks like. We will be taking the children on a walk around the local area on 2nd February. We would then like to take them on a proper hike to **Queen Elizabeth Country Park on 11th February.**

For the visit to Queen Elizabeth Country park, we will need to use minibuses so the cost of the trip is **£5.50.** The children will need to be in full uniform but wearing comfortable walking trousers and shoes. I recommend old trainers or wellies that will be comfortable to walk in and you don't mind them getting a bit muddy. The children will need a warm waterproof coat as we will still go if it is raining or cold. Umbrellas will not be appropriate to bring. Children may bring a backpack to carry their water bottles and coats if they remove them.

Owls will go 9 – 12 and return for lunchtime as normal.

Blackbirds will go 10:30 – 1:30 and eat a packed lunch in their class when they return.

If your child is a Blackbird, you will receive a link to an online form where you can pre-order their lunch.

As a reward for their hike, and to warm them up, we will be taking hot chocolate to have afterwards.
