We encourage the children to wear black plimsolls or plain black trainers.




## Attendance


## Reporting School Absence

On Thursday 5th March 2026, we will be celebrating World Book Day at Grange Infant School!

Children are invited to attend school dressed up as either their favourite character from any beloved book or comic, as their favourite author, or simply wear clothing that has a fictional character such as a t-shirt with a character on it.
