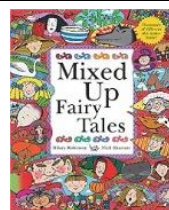


English

We will be designing and sewing fairy tale finger puppets in DT!



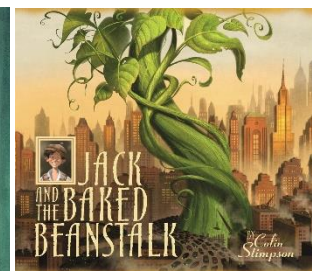
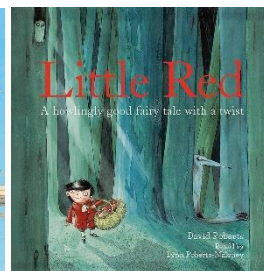
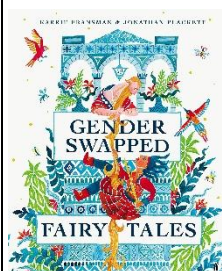
Geography
