We will continue to develop our skills in:

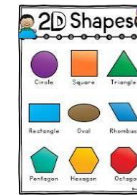
- Punctuation

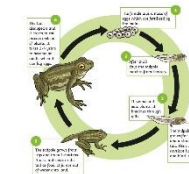
