We are learning about the continents and oceans of the world through map work. We will look at their climates and see which animals live there.

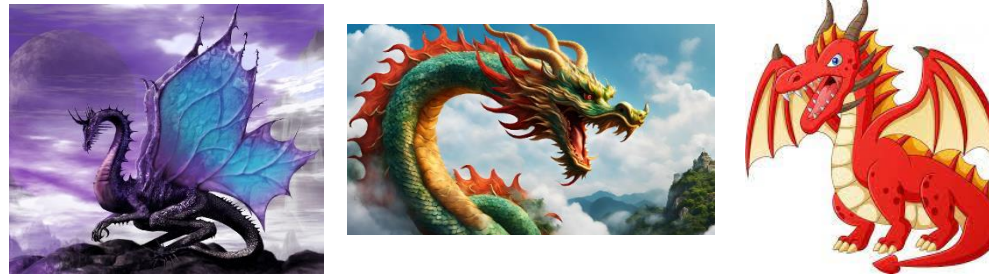


Science

We will look at levers & pivots to help us design and make a moving dragon using split pins.



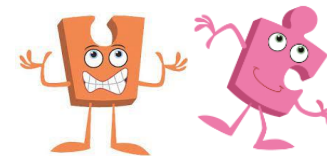
We will also study local artist 'My Dog Sighs' and draw an eye for our dragon.
