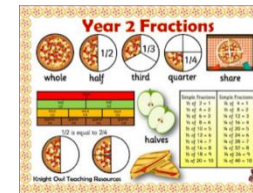
Please aim to read with your child 3 times a week or try out Oxford Owl online.

We will be using the atlas to help us find out and name the countries of the UK and their capital cities. We will compare facts and features of these cities.



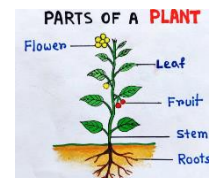
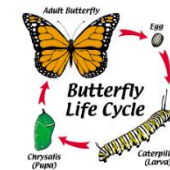
