Communication and language



We will be developing our language following the word aware programme. Each week we will learn new vocabulary through stories and actions.

Chatterbox will continue. One of our Role Play areas will transform into a rocket/ space station!

Book chat will continue.

English



The children will now be settled into their phonics groups. Some children will recap SSSI while others will begin learning SSS2 and reading Ditty photocopies/Ditty books. We will be focusing on handwriting, writing CVC words and 2-word phrases. We also will have started teaching the common exception words called 'Gruffalo words'. These will be sent home for you to practice.

Ways you can help your child with literacy:

- Read with your child at least 3 times a week.
- Practise saying the sounds and writing the correct letter formation.
- Use the word time sheet to practise blending sounds to read words.
- Practice your Gruffalo words 3 times a week.

Physical Development



In PE the children will be developing their ball skills.

Dough disco will continue and funky finger activities will be accessed daily in the provision.

Most days the children will have access to the bikes and scoolers in our outside areas.



This half term is all about space. We will be exploring our planet, where we live and space. We will be looking at rocket ship take offs, exploring the concept of gravity and looking at our Earth. We will also be looking at dinosaurs and reading alien stories. Our focus stories are: 'How to catch a star', 'Aliens love underpants', 'Bob the man on the moon', 'Here we are' and 'The way back home'.

Mathematics



This half term we will start with a focus number bonds to 5 and 10. This is different ways you can make 5 and 10. After we will move onto exploring adding 2 groups together ready for addition.
