#### Communication and language

## English



Read Write Inc: The children who are not yet blending need plenty of practise at home with sound tiles and reading books — ask your class teacher if you would like any more resources.

Gruffalo words will continue to be assessed and sent home. Please practise these on a daily basis and look for them in the reading books.

We will be starting 'Drawing Club': a fun engaging way to encouraging drawing and writina!

Ways you can help your child with literacy:

- Read with your child at least 3 times a week.
- Practise saying the sounds and writing the correct letter formation.
- Use the word time sheet to practise blending sounds to read words.
- Practice your Gruffalo words 3 times a week

## Physical Development



In PE this half term we will be looking at Dance. We will be exploring movement to music and how we can move different parts of our bodies to portray a feeling or embody an animal. Dough disco will continue weekly and children will have access to fine-motor activities during Busy Bee time.



This half term is all about farms. The children will be looking at what farms are, how they work and what animals live there. We will be looking at farms on google-earth and exploring the land around farms. We will be looking at life-cycles of animals and their characteristics.

### Mathematics



The children will be continuing to look at addition and be introduced to subtraction At the end of the term we will be exploring shape, space and measure.

## Expressive arts and design



We will be looking at different instruments and the sounds they make. We will have a music unit on drumming. In Busy Bee time, we will have the opportunity to make our own instruments.
